The Georgia State University School of Music in partnership with the Georgia State library and Johnny Mercer Foundation is pleased to offer several graduate assistantships for students enrolling in the Master of Music degree in Music Education.

1. Tuition waiver for four semesters
2. \$2000 stipend per semester for a total of \$8000.
3. Recipients currently teaching in a school setting will design their curriculum unit for their school and students.

Recipients not currently teaching in a school setting will design their curriculum unit for Georgia State partnership schools. The Master of Music Education degree typically is completed in two years by full-time students, with much of the coursework available in the evening or online.


